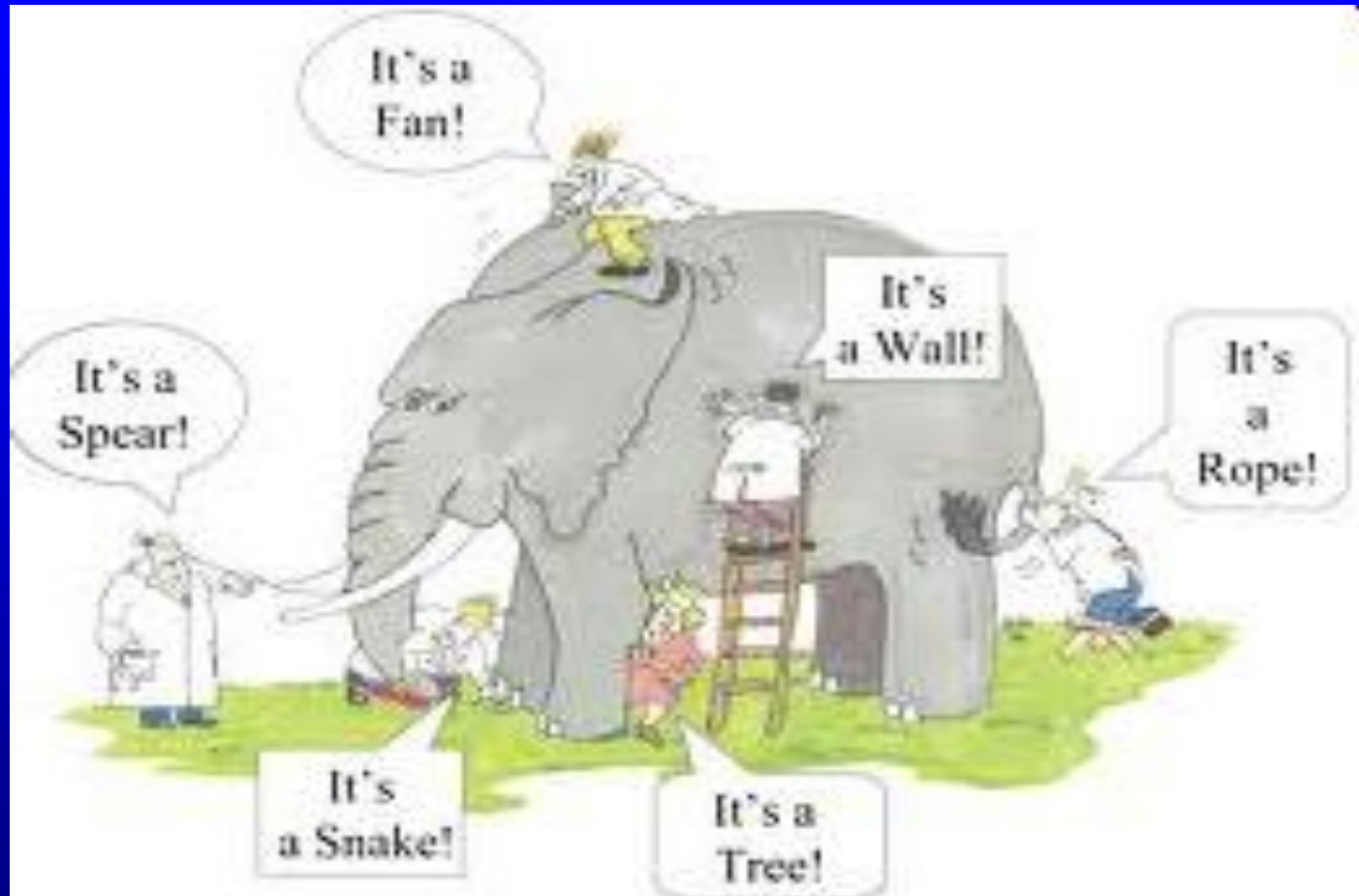

- On February 19, 2009, the Section for Clinical Pharmacology of the Serbian Medical Society was established in the Serbian Medical Society, with the aim of implementing the knowledge of clinical pharmacology in all medical fields such as hospital pharmacology
